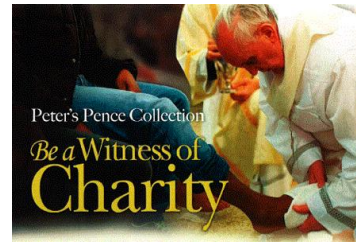

A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

“The taking away of her political authority, and the robbery made of her temporal possessions, tend necessarily to increase the reliance of the Church upon God, and to fasten and strengthen her confidence in her spiritual forces and character. This idea has been repeatedly expressed by the Holy Father, and the actual effect throughout the Church has been increased spiritual life and energy. Already many signs of this increased spiritual activity have appeared. Among these are the formation of new associations for prayer, circles for the encouragement of Christian workingmen, societies for the advancement of true science, the utilizing of the press, etc.” [On the Mission of New Religious Communities, 1876]
