Ethics In Integrity Ministry: Basics & Refresher Workshop June 25, 2016

All persons serving in **any ministry requiring EIM compliance** (clergy, paid staff, volunteers working with youth and vulnerable adults, liturgical ministers, choir) **must**:

1. Complete the EIM Application for Ministry (one time only), which permits the diocese to run a background check and creates the EIM account where workshop attendance is recorded.
2. Attend an EIM workshop (Basic within 60 days of application submission) and within every 3 years thereafter.

The Diocese of Austin is committed to preventing harm from happening to any of our children or vulnerable adults. If you suspect, or are aware of sexual or physical abuse and/or neglect of a child or vulnerable adult, state law requires you to report that information to local law enforcement or the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services at **(800) 252-5400** or www.dfps.state.tx.us. Additionally, if the suspected abuse is by clergy or an employee or volunteer of any diocesan parish, school or agency, a Notice of Concern should be submitted to the diocesan Ethics and Integrity in Ministry Office at **(512) 949-2400**. The Notice of Concern can be found at www.austindiocese.org (click on REPORT ABUSE OR AN EIM CONCERN). Reports may be made anonymously.
