St. Paul's Honor Garden - Update

Having just celebrated the Fourth of July, birth of our country, I am reminded that we, the parish, had hoped to be dedicating our Honor Garden remembering and giving thanks for those who have served our nation. Unfortunately, we have run into an unexpected obstacle.

Initially our architect estimated our cost at approximately \$160,000. We have worked towards that goal and raised just over \$100,000. Our plan was to continue fundraising as we began construction. Our discovery after putting the garden out for bids is that not many companies wanted to undertake such a small project and secondly, the bid that we did get was well over the estimate. Now faced with having to raise an additional \$160,000, we found ourselves daunted by such a task.

The good news is that we have not been discouraged by this setback. It is truly a setback and so it means that we will have to work harder to make up the difference. We need help with finding donors who are supportive of such a unique project as ours and are willing to help it become a reality. We need your help.

“I formerly thought that we should not make new foundations because our Fathers were divided on some points and for other reasons. But when I considered how others in our circumstances had made ventures in past ages of the Church, relying on God, then I began to think differently. ... And if it be said that a new foundation taking five or six men would badly cripple us, I answer that God would supply the want; we would rely blindly on God.” [June 1885]
