A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

“The work that Divine Providence has called us as a religious community to do in our own country, were its spirit extended throughout Europe, would be the focus and element of its regeneration. For our country has a providential position in view of Europe, and our baptizing it, and our efforts to Catholicize and sanctify it, give it an importance in a religious aspect of a most interesting and significant character.” [Letter to Hecker’s Family during his Novitiate, 1846]
