WWICS Donates \$20K Rummage Sale Proceed to Building Fund

The Women Working in Communion and Spirit Board this week donated \$20,000 in net proceeds from their 2016 Rummage Sale to the St. Paul's Parish Building Fund. The fundraiser project, which involved nearly everyone in the parish--whether as worker, donor, or both--raised \$22,000 in gross proceeds. The board also voted a special commendation for Rummage Sale organizers Althea Rowan, Brenda Kerr and Lesley McCallick for their untiring work throughout the summer on the huge project and thanked the dozens of volunteers who donated thousands of man-hours to make the sale a success. This is the second major gift to our Building Fund WWICS has been able to make this year. In May, the organization donated \$10,000, which it raised producing and selling *From Our Table to Yours*, the parish cookbook.
