A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

“Oh Lord. Lord forgive me my sins and save me from all errors and lead me in the path that thou wouldst have me go. Is there no one who I can go to that may open my eyes that I may see. Oh Lord direct me. And if thou directest me now give me faith in thy means. I am Oh Father one of thy children: thou knowest all that I do. My heart is open to thy inspection. Do not let me suffer for thou art tender compassionate and full of love. Let me see: open thou my eyes, and grant that I may hear thy voice more distinctly.” [Diary, June 19, 1843]
