"Are we Christians if we act not in the spirit which Christ acted. Shall we say what we shall do? Follow the spirit of Christ which is in you "unless ye are reprobates ye have it in you" wherever however and withsoever it lead you. Be ye faithfull as I am said Jesus. Love one another as I have Loved you. Take up your cross and follow him. Leave all if the spirit leades you to leave all. Do whatever it leades you to do. There will not be any lack of action. Let him be all in all."
