“Ah Ah that I were wholly submissive to the motion of Gods love. I know not. I know not, what I shall say, or what I shall do. Oh Lord do Thou with me what Thou wilt. Lord wilt Thou wholly take me to thyself. Ah that I did but give up my whole self to thee. Lord embrace me and say that I am thine – all – all Thine!” [Diary, February 16, 1845]
