"The Greeks with their speculative and subtle intellect penetrated into the sublime mysteries and truths of Christianity and clothed them with proper expressions; the Latins with their practical genius for government and law developed the hierarchy and discipline of the Church. As, for instance, the definition of the central mystery of the Christian faith, that of the Most Holy Trinity, is due to the intellectual gifts of the former, and the definition of papal Infallibility as an article of Catholic faith, the central point of the ecclesiastical hierarchy and government, is the fruit of the practical genius of the latter, yet in both cases under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. The Latin-Celts with an imaginative and emotional nature have contributed to the development of her devotion and aesthetics."
