Street Improvements

The reconstruction of the streets serving St. Paul's facilities started sooner than anticipated this past week, and will continue for the next six weeks or so. This project phase includes Dalton Circle, Scott Drive and Hi Ridge Road down to the "STOP" sign at Thanksgiving Mountain. During the reconstruction jobs of curbing, re-basing and finalizing for paving, the streets will be drivable, and access to our St. Paul parking lots will be available, especially evenings and weekends. Access will be limited for a few hours when all of the streets undergo final paving together.
