A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

"Oh may I become more obedient meek Humble like Jesus Christ my master Lord and saving Redeemer to whom and to thee and to the holy spirit my soul is indebted wholly without measure. Oh make my heart more devout; inspire my soul; raise my thoughts and may thy spirit dwell in me in fullness to overflowing. Lord help me to overcome all self will to crucify self so that there may be nothing of the old Man left and that I may be a new Man born begotten in the Lord Jesus Christ who in heaven on the right hand of God giving help to all those who ask in sincerity and truth"
[Diary, August 9, 1843]
