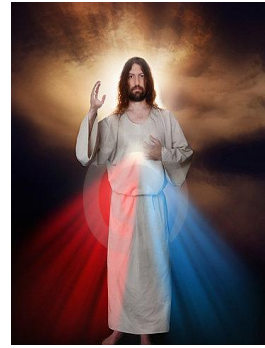

A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

“Oh Lord wilt thou guide me and lead me no matter in what pain or distress I may have to pass through to the true path which thou wouldst have me to go in. Oh I thank thee for all that thou hast in any way inflicted me. It has been to me the greatest blessing I could have received. And oh Lord chasten me more for I need it. How shall I live that I may be the best I can be under my conditions? And if these conditions in which I am placed are not the best where shall I go or how shall I change them. Teach me oh Lord and hear my humble prayer.”

[Diary, November 4, 1843]
