“Lord what can I say sufficiently to tell my unworthiness. No language can speak it Thou knowest Lord how wicked I am. This moment Thou seest how I fear Thee. How little trust I put in Thee. Oh Lord it is a wonder that Thou sufferest me to live. Mercy mercy mercy oh Lord God on thy unworthy not to be named Thy Child.” [Diary, January 20, 1845]
