A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

"Here is my difficulty oh Lord and do Thou direct me. I am always in doubt when I do not think of Thee alone that I am sinning and my time is misspent. Yet how can I think of thee at all times when my studies call attention from Thee. These oh Lord I offer to thee with deep humility. May all that I do be done to Thy great glory. My heart would be drinking always from Thy living fountain of love. But how shall I best serve thee oh my God and Saviour? Ah let all be devoted to thee, to thee alone. Let me not be distracted from Thee." [Diary, February 16, 1845]
