HEB and Bayside Market Gift Cards

- **Our “Support St. Paul Every Day” program allows parishioners to purchase prepaid cards that are used just like cash.** St. Paul buys the cards at a discount and re-sells these cards at face value. Patrons receive 100% of the cards’ value. Discounts ranging from 5-10% provide **additional revenue for debt reduction at no additional cost to our patrons.** **Prepaid cards can be obtained during the week at the parish office and before and after the Masses on the first weekend in May. . The list of participating retailers includes HEB and Bayside Fresh Market.** Obtain the order form, fill it out, and return it with a check or cash to the office or at Mass. Buy early and often for the summer, especially the holidays. (Memorial Day and 4th of July). **These are the cards that are in stock regularly:** HEB: \$20, \$50, \$100 Bayside Fresh Market: \$50, \$100 **Volunteers are needed to sell the cards at all Masses.** Time commitment is flexible. **Prepaid cards are a way for everyone, no matter their means, to financially support the church as it is a 'no-cost' fundraiser.** If we keep up our initial average weekly sales, CARDS will bring in over \$18,000 to St. Paul for debt reduction. "Oh Jesus who gavest up thy blessed self for us unworthy sinners, who countedst thyself nothing that we might be saved, to whom all things were as nothing in comparison to our wretched but immortal Souls, Ah Jesus blessed Saviour give me a taste of Thy divine humility and detestation of this world and all its empty and vain things. Oh Lord purify me from all self, pride, ambition, and love of the world." [Diary, February 16, 1845]
