I want to report that our Parish is doing quite well. We seem to be increasing the number of registered parishioners and growing in numbers. As his tenure has come to an end, we have had to search for another capable and willing parishioner to help us maintain the financial responsibilities of our parish. As of this week, Mark Bentley has accepted the challenge and is willing to serve. I thank him for his generosity. Coincidentally, together with the support of the Finance Council, I have decided to adjust our Fiscal year to match the Diocesan Fiscal year which starts on July 1st and ends June 30th. We have been on a calendar year, January 1 - December 31. This will enable us to better relate to the Diocesan records and reports. As a result, we are postponing our yearly financial report to the parish until sometime in early Fall. This will allow us to adjust our budget to the new fiscal year. Ethic & Integrity in Ministry- Austin Diocese

EIM compliance is required of all clergy, diocesan employees, parish employees, and adult lay persons who volunteer in ministry with minors or vulnerable adults, or in any ministry, program or organization that serves youth or vulnerable adults in any manner, or functions at a time and place where they are typically present. *To be compliant, one submits an EIM Application for Ministry (one time only) and attends an EIM Workshop every three years.*

If you have never completed an application, or are in need of attending a workshop to be compliant, please complete your application on the EIM Austin Diocese website.

Patrons receive 100% of the cards' value. Discounts ranging from 5-10% provide **additional revenue for debt reduction at no additional cost to our patrons.**

“Oh Lord help me–me-me. Not for my sake but for my Souls sake-may it not be cast into the place of darkness & death. Mother of God befriend me. St. Augustine aid me in my studies, St. Francis oh give me help to love and practice the poverty & humility thou didst, St. Teresa tech me the spirit of obedience and meekness, Oh Lord save me not for myself but for the glory of God alone.” [Diary, March 15, 1845]
